## The Science Connection: Iron Oxide Experiment

- 1. Record the beginning temperature on the data chart.
- 2. Put the steel wool inside the vinegar for 30 seconds.
- 3. Squeeze out the vinegar until it doesn't drip.
- 4. Wrap the steel wool around the bottom of the thermometer and attach it with a rubber band.
- 5. Hang the thermometer on the inside of the jar using the tape.
- 6. Close the lid.
- 7. Record the temperature inside the jar every 2 minutes.
