History Strategies Historical Map

This strategy allows students to use their math skills, organize information from a passage, and demonstrate an understanding of directionality and geography.

- 1. Have the students read a passage about a historical person.
- 2. Draw a map that includes all of the places (states and countries) that the historical person has visited.
- 3. Draw the route on the map, in chronological order, labeling the names of the places visited by the historical person.
- 4. Have the students prepare a written report about the historical person's travels, and have them tape or glue it to the back of the map.
